Authorize the Chief Executive Officer for Natividad Medical Center (NMC) or his designee to execute amendment No. 9 to the agreement (A-13298) with Net Health Systems, Inc. for physical therapy outpatient, scheduling, home exercise, analytics (ReDoc xFit) and Agility packages,, extending the agreement an additional one (1) year period (December 1, 2024 through November 30, 2025) for a revised full agreement term of August 31, 2016 through November 30, 2025, and adding \$81,788 for a revised total agreement amount not to exceed \$680,617.

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

NMC's outpatient Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy and Speech Therapy Departments currently uses the ReDoc software in conjunction with the hospital's Meditech system for scheduling and billing. ReDoc is in use as Meditech does not presently offer an outpatient solution for Therapy medical record documentation. Net Health is a nationally recognized company that provides rehabilitation documentation software solutions to more than 500 outpatient therapy sites and is considered an industry leader for outpatient therapy online documentation.

Net Health's enterprise solution provides therapists and therapy teams with the tools they need to operate efficiently, stay compliant, and enhance patient care and outcomes. Outpatient Therapy is strictly regulated by regulatory agencies, and the ReDoc software keeps current with changes in regulations and billing requirements. Patient care is also enhanced by using ReDoc, as the software allows the therapist to generate comprehensive reports that convey medical necessity and functional outcomes to send to the patient's provider. Additional benefits of using ReDoc, is the software's ability to alert the therapist to any billing or coding errors and provides reminders for critical events, such as progress reports, re-certifications, and re-authorizations, all while tracking Medicare Cap limits. The ReDoc software also provides appointment scheduling, patient reminders, robust analytics, billing, and management reports. ReDoc also provides point-of-care alerts to the therapist related to therapy caps, re-authorization requirements, and other critical events during the patient's therapy.

In addition, NMC utilizes Net Health's AgilityEH software package for the purpose of recording and tracking services that are provided to employees by the Employee Health Department. This software allows NMC to better monitor and report services rendered, such as TB Screening, Respiratory Fit Testing, Exposure Management and Vaccination Administration to meet regulatory requirements for employee health services.

Authorize the Chief Executive Officer for Natividad Medical Center or his designee to execute amendment No. 7 to the agreements with Receivable Solutions, Inc. (A-13320) pursuant to the Request for Proposal (RFP) #9600-64 for debt collection services, to extend an additional nine-month period (October 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025) for a revised full agreement term of October 1, 2016 through June 30, 2025 and adding \$2,700,000 for a revised total aggregate amount for all contracts not to exceed \$12,970,000.

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

Natividad Medical Center utilizes two outside contractors, per RFP 9600-64 to collect on Natividad Medical Center's self-pay patients and bad debt collections. The contractor shall receive four (4) daily data files of all self-pay patients from Natividad Medical Center's Meditech system. With this information, the contractors will be responsible to send three (3) collection notices to the patient within a 150-day time-frame requesting payment. The contractors are responsible for arranging and setting up a payment plan for services incurred at Natividad Medical Center. If there is no response, the patients account is put into a bad debt collection for further collection efforts. Liens are applied as appropriate.

Payment is based on the amount of debt collected and is, therefore, an unknown, so the agreement documents themselves do not state a total agreement amount specifically. Natividad Medical Center is requesting an increased aggregate dollar limit for both agreements not to exceed \$12,970,000 which reflects an estimated amount Natividad Medical Center might pay for debt collection fees through June 30, 2025.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

County Counsel has reviewed and approved this amendment No. 7 as to legal form, and the Auditor-Controller has reviewed and approved as to payment provisions. The Amendment is scheduled to be reviewed by Natividad Medical Center's Finance Committee and Board of Trustees on October 11, 2024, after the Board of Supervisors' consideration of this Amendment at its September 10, 2024

meeting. Seeking Board of Supervisors approval first was necessary in order to prevent a gap in services.

FINANCING:

The cost for this amendment No. 7 is \$2,700,000 of which \$750,000 is included in the Fiscal Year 2024-25 Adopted Budget. Amounts for remaining years of the agreement will be included in those budgets as appropriate. Funding will be provided from NMC's Enterprise Fund 451-9600-6613.
